## Introduction

The Lighthouse Club is delighted to arrange this unique event at which past winners of the Lighthouse Club's annual Golden Helmet Award will discuss the state of construction site safety and health in Hong Kong, the advances and improvements made over the past 20 years since the Golden Helmet Award was first awarded in 1999 and the challenges and opportunities ahead. The Golden Helmet is the Lighthouse Club's most prestigious award, recognising those who have made significant contributions to advances and improvements in safety and health in our construction industry. The distinguished guests include current and past leaders in the Hong Kong construction industry and this is a rare opportunity to hear from them altogether on this unique occasion.

The Golden Helmet was donated to the Lighthouse Club Hong Kong Branch in 1999 by the BCJ (British-Chinese -Japanese) Joint Venture who had constructed Terminal 1 of the then recently opened Hong Kong International Airport at Chek Lap Kok with the intention that it be awarded annually to senior persons in the construction industry who have made significant contributions to construction site safety.

Special focus is given to "Design for Safety" in this unique event, as we intend to cascade a caring culture to all Clients, Owners, Designers for permanent works, and Designers for temporary works, in furtherance of Lighthouse Club's motto "Consideration for Others".
